3. This website will also serve as a forum for the organizations working within and outside the consortium. For example, any effect of a transgenic plantation needs to be discussed in the context of already existing and accepted forestry practice.

2. To update the website with science-based information for public interest in the utilization of GMTs in forest plantation and at the same time safeguarding the environment (with information provided by WG1, WG2, WG3)
3. To update the website with information for further environmental impacts assessment to assist EU policy (with information provided by WG1, WG2, WG3)
4. To use all the information collected to identify particular topics which could be useful to develop research projects (in collaboration with WG1, WG2, WG3, WG4)
5. To summarize in a book the knowledge gained as a final output of this Action (joint publication within WGs)



The new European COST action (FP0905) "Biosafety of forest transgenic trees: improving the scientific basis for safe tree development and implementation of EU policy directives" (<http://www.cost-action-fp0905.eu/>) has recently been approved. 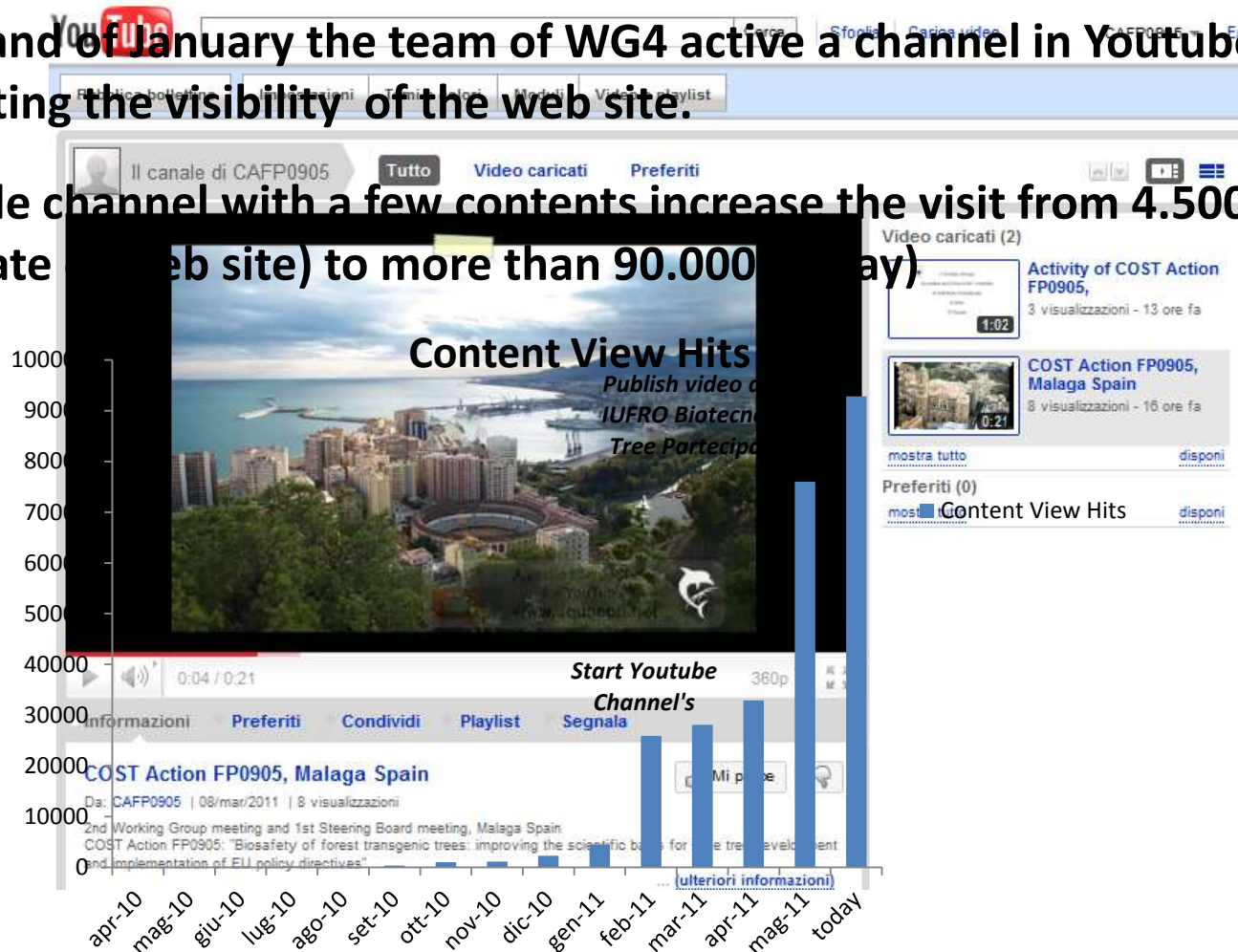


3. Youtube Channel Cost Action FP0905
